

Summer Mission Experience



EPPIC engages in summer mission trips that begin in July and end in August. These trips are determined a year in advance to give participants ample time to raise the prayer and financial support required to fund their summer experience. Summer mission experiences can be domestic tours and/or international mission trips. The summer mission experience is a great way to get familiar with EPPIC if you are considering working with EPPIC on a full-time basis and applying for participation in Project R.E.S.T.

There is a cost to participation in R.E.S.T. You will be required to put forth an effort to raise prayer and financial support for your participation prior to traveling to Minneapolis where all training take place. Summer participants generally need to raise a minimum of \$1500 for their three-month summer

experience with EPPIC. EPPIC staff members will help you raise a prayer support “Team of Ten” and help you work through the support raising process.

A \$200 non-refundable deposit is required by March 15 before the June start date. This demonstrates a participant’s resolve to pursue the summer mission experience with EPPIC Ministries International.

A \$500 project cost for each participant is due by April 15 before the June start date. This covers all things related to the training EPPIC will be providing. This project cost pays for administrative expenses, all written materials, the trainers’ time, rental space(s) and an EPPIC Crew shirt.

EPPIC recognizes that each participant’s financial situation is different and each projects schedule and itinerary is subject to change. Therefore, EPPIC works with each participant to determine their support raising goal to cover expenses related to housing and accommodations while in Minneapolis and travel costs when you are on tour.

This does not include the \$200 non-refundable deposit or the \$500 project cost. Costs increase depending upon the ministry the summer crew undertakes. If the crew tours domestically it is less expensive then touring internationally. We set a \$2500 cap on funds needed to be raised for any summer ministry we do domestically or internationally.

Variables that affect the summer mission experience expenses include what type of accommodations (housing and meals) that are made for participants during their time in Minneapolis, whether-or-not their mime crew travels domestically or internationally and costs related to travel in-country (housing, food, transportation) when traveling abroad.
